We strive to offer learners in SD62 flexibility and choice, opportunities for enrichment, and alternative pathways to graduation. Opportunities and programs supported by SD62 Online include online and blended learning via D2L's Brightspace learning management system (LMS), Online Learning Hubs at SD62's traditional Secondary Schools (Belmont, EMCS, and Royal Bay), SD62 Academy program's online Academy courses, Middle School Blended Learning at Spencer Middle School, online learning for adults via SD62 Continuing Education, and SD62's Full Credit Summer Learning program.
